

TRIP PLAN SAFARI & ZANZIBAR

JANUARY - 2026



DAY 1: JRO TO ARUSHA



Upon your arrival at Kilimanjaro airport, your guide will pick you up and transfer you to your hotel in Arusha. Where you can relax and enjoy the African atmosphere -Tomorrow you will have a full day leisure as you wait for an amazing experience.

Accommodation: Kibo Palace

DAY 2: RELAXING DAY

Today will be a wonderful, relaxing day. If you like you can spend the whole day at the lodge being spoiled by the staff, having drinks served at the pool, and enjoying the wonderful scenery of Arusha. Close your eyes and listen to the sounds of nature that you will only hear in Tanzania. Relax in this wonderful African atmosphere that allows you to leave all your worries behind...

DAY 3: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK



After breakfast, the tour departs heading off on safari to Tarangire National Park for a game drive. Tarangire is well known for its huge elephant population and baobab trees. It forms the center of an annual migratory cycle that includes up to 3000 elephants, 25,000 wildebeest, and 30,000 zebras.

Accommodation: Maramboi Tented Lodge

DAY 4: NGORONGORO NDUTU AREA

After breakfast you will depart with a picnic lunch in hand towards the Ngorongoro Ndutu Area. Upon your arrival at the NCAA gate, you will take care of the park formalities and fees before making your way to your game drive in Ngorongoro Ndutu Area. During this season you will be able to see the hundreds of thousands of wildebeest CALVES.

Accommodation: Ndutu Luxury Lodge



DAY 5: NGORONGORO NDUTU AREA



After breakfast, you will continue with your game drive in this area to experience an amazing calving season where hundreds of thousands calves are being born in this season after the short rain that makes the new sprout of grass for the calves. This season has the only world remarkable Rhythm which makes a very good sound of music as we call it sound of nature from wildebeest.

Accommodation: Ndutu Luxury Lodge

DAY 6: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, depart for Serengeti National Park, via the beautiful high lying farmland of Karatu and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Leaving the highlands behind, we descend into the heart of wild Africa – the Serengeti National Park – with its endless plains, rolling into the distance as far as the eye can see. Then head to the central park area, known as the Seronera area, one of the richest wildlife habitats in the park, featuring the Seronera River, which provides a valuable water source to this area and therefore attracts wildlife well representative of most of the Serengeti's species. Arrive in time for lunch and enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Serengeti national park.



Accommodation: Serengeti Serena

DAY 7: NGORONGORO CRATER



After an early breakfast, you will descend into the crater to view wildlife. Supported by a year round water supply and fodder, the Ngorongoro conservation Area supports variety of animals, which include herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo, and giant African elephants. Another big draw card to this picturesque national park, is its dense population of predators, which include lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs and the ever-elusive leopard, which sometimes requires a trained eye to spot. We will visit Lake Magadi, a large but shallow alkaline lake in the southwestern corner, which is one of the main features of the crater. A large number of flamingos, hippos and other water birds can usually be seen here. Late afternoon transfer to Arusha For Overnight stay.

Accommodation: Kibo Palace

DAY 8: FLIGHT FROM ARUSHA TO DAR ES SALAAM

Today you will take your flight from Arusha Airport (ARK) to Julius Nyerere International Airport (DAR) and arrive in Dar es Salaam specifically at Terminal 2. It will be roughly 2:30 hours flight . You will be picked at the airport and head towards Bagamoyo a safari that will take 2 hours based on traffic conditions and head to your hotel for relaxation as you wait to experience the historical sites in Bagamoyo on the next day .

Accommodation: Firefly Boutique Lodge

DAY 9: BAGAMOYO HISTORICAL SITES

Today after breakfast, your guide will pick you at the hotel and head to various historical sites. Bagamoyo was once a major port in the slave trade and center for colonial administration. The likes of the Old Fort, Caravan Serai, kaole Ruins. It will be a full day fantasy with an experienced guide that will share with you the history of various key historical slave sites. You will be free to ask as many questions as you enjoy this adventure.

DAY 10: A VISIT TO BOUNTY ISLAND ZANZIBAR



Today you will take a ferry from Dar es Salaam to Zanzibar. One of our drivers will be there to pick you up and bring you to your hotel. Real relaxation starts here! Enjoy tropical Zanzibar! 

DAY 17: ENJOY A BIT MORE BEFORE GOING HOME




Enjoy the last few hours of your trip before our driver comes to pick you up and you commence the journey home.


